The Council shall, based on the recommendations of the Commission, apply the provisions of this Part on a transparent, uniform and non-discriminatory basis ~~manner~~, and shall ensure equality of financial treatment [and comparable financial obligations for Contractors] ~~[to counter any disparity arising out of any grossly incomparable concentration of given resources].~~

5. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

It is not for international regulations to compensate or “counter” disparities arising from the natural disposition of mineral resources throughout the oceans. To assume this role would not be consistent with the approach taken by UNCLOS, which recognizes the existence of significant differences in national maritime spaces and associated resources and does not try to “counter” such disparities. UNCLOS Part XI allows compensation due to the need of developing States or to environmental harm. Moreover, the new attribution to counter disparities arising out of different concentrations of resources would insert an element of uncertainty in the executive functions of the Council. Therefore, we would prefer to delete the final part of proposed Regulation 62.
