Regulation 30 [President's Text]
Safety, labour and health standards

1. The Contractor shall ensure at all times that:

For the avoidance of doubt, any changes made to the Health and Safety Plan and Maritime Security Plan for the purpose of this sub-paragraph are not Material Changes.]

- We support the continuous improvement of Health and Safety and Maritime Security Plans and ensuring these are kept up to date.
- To support this, we consider it important to ensure that these changes to the Plans do not trigger the Draft Regulation's requirements around Material Changes. Otherwise, attempts to continuously improve these Plans will be hampered and slowed down.
