4. The Secretary-General shall supply all information received pursuant to paragraph 3(b) to the Commission for its review and to make a recommendation to the Council. The Council shall, based on the recommendation of the Commission determine when if the relevant Exploitation activities should recommence, giving the Contractor no less than 60 Days' written notice where resumption of activities is required.

In making its review under paragraph 4, the Commission shall <u>consult with the</u> <u>Contractor and</u> take into account the recommendations of the Economic Planning Commission where applicable, and shall examine whether the reasons for the suspension are reasonable, and whether a continued suspension or a recommencement of activities <u>is appropriate</u>, would <u>be in the best interests of humankind</u> in the circumstances.

Para 2: this para is currently too opened ended and could be read as allowing the Authority to require suspension of activities for any reason. We suggest the paragraph is modified as above.

Para 4: it is important that the Council base any decision on the recommendation of the Commission. The Commission is best placed to assess the reasons for any continuing suspension in operations.

Para 5: the Commission should also consult with the Contractor. There may be strong commercial reasons why any suspension should continue. We do not consider such an
