Regulation 10

- 1. The Secretary-General shall preliminarily review an application for approval of a Plan of Work and determine whether the application contains all the information required by Regulations 5 to 8 for further processing.
- 1 Bis. Where the Secretary-General considers that an application does not contain all the information required by Regulations 5 to 8, the Secretary-General shall submit it to the Legal and Technical Commission.
- 2. Where the <u>Legal and Technical Commission Secretary-General</u> determines that an application does not contain all the information required by Regulations 5 to 8, the Secretary-General shall, within 45 Days of receipt of the application, notify the applicant, specifying the information which the applicant must submit in order to complete the application, and a date by which the application must be completed. Further processing of an application will not begin until the <u>Legal and Technical Commission Secretary-General</u> determines that the application is complete, which includes all required information that has been submitted by the applicant, including payment of the administrative fee specified in appendix II.
