Instead, the applicant shall provide supporting materials in relation to the mature mining technology when submitting the application.

Test Mining here is not the Test Mining referred to in regulation 48ter of the draft Exploitation Regulations, but is derived from the Exploration Regulations and the LTC "Recommendations for the guidance of contractors for the assessment of the possible environmental impacts arising from exploration for marine minerals in the Area" (ISBA/25/LTC/6/Rev.3), which is analyzed in detail in Part I of China's General Comments.
