(b) bis Be based on the best available [science and] scientific information, and, [if applicable, taking into account,]where available, relevant traditional knowledge of Indigenous Peoples and <u>of</u> local communities;

(e) Be subject to an independent scientific assessment prior to the submission of the proposed Environmental Impact Statement to the Authority;

4. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

The FSM proposes to revise paragraph 3(b)bis of DR 46 to delete the comma after "scientific information" and to replace "if applicable, taking into account," with "where available," as the latter is the typical formulation elsewhere in the DRs (as well as in the EIAs Part of the BBNJ Agreement). We also propose to insert "of" before "local communities" in order to distinguish the traditional knowledge of Indigenous Peoples from the traditional knowledge of local communities.

The FSM also proposes to delete the reference to "scientific" in paragraph 3(e) of the same DR 46 to align with the reference to traditional knowledge in paragraph 3(b)bis as a complement to science for the EIA process.
