Regarding DR 71, we support the proposed inclusion of new paragraph 1(e), which aims to ensure that the Authority is appropriately informed, to the degree possible, of sales beyond the Contract Area, as a means of due diligence with regards the entire value chain.

We wish to raise in this regard that how minerals from the Area are processed and used is a question not only of financial interest, but also of environmental, social and human rights standards. Processing or mineral ore can produce significant volume of tailings (waste products) that may be toxic or present hazards to the environment and communities where they are stored. Although we appreciate that such matters may not fall directly under the ISA's jurisdiction for regulatory purposes, the ISA is responsible to ensure that the common heritage resources of the Area are developed for the benefit of humankind as a whole, and this would not be served by enabling downstream processes that, for example, cause environmental crimes, loss of life or other human rights abuses.
