We support DR 83, but suggest the drafting of paragraph 1 should be amended to make it enforceable regulatory language. In making this proposal, we are presuming that the intention behind DR83 is to mirror the Extractives Industry Transparency Initiative, which requires both the mining company making a payment, and the authority receiving the payment, to publish the information about their payments separately. This allows the public and other stakeholders to reconcile between the two reports, with the purpose to avoid public monies going missing or unaccounted for.

We would prefer however that the two paragraphs here be moved to more relevant regulations elsewhere in the text (such as DR 89 on confidentiality of information, for paragraph 1, and DR 92 on the Seabed Mining Register for paragraph 2).
