Upon expiration termination of an Exploitation Contract in accordance with regulation 18 ter,; or if an application for renewal is refused after the original expiration date, upon the date of the refusal; or if an Exploitation Contract is terminated before its expiration date, upon the date of the termination] The Contractor shall transfer to the Authority, [to the extent feasible] within [90][180] Days [from the date of the expiration of the contract, the date of the refusal of an application for renewal, or date the of termination of the contract] in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation and the [applicable] Standard[s], and taking into consideration account Guidelines:
- (a) transfer all data and information that are required for the effective exercise of the powers and functions of the Authority in respect of the Contract Area, and;
- (b) to the extent requested by the Authority, transfer biological, chemical and geological samples collected under the Contract to the Authority or other location(s) specified by the Authority in accordance with the provisions of this Regulation and the [applicable] Standard[s], and taking into consideration account Guidelines.

DR18(ter) sets out all the circumstances in which a contract may end (termination by the ISA, natural expiration, surrender by the Contractor). This aligns with Annex X (standard contract clauses) which specifies that termination may arise "for any reason (including the passage of time)." If that draft I of DR18(ter) is retained, then DR91 can be greatly simplified by cross-reference to DR18(ter).

Paragraph (2) as drafted raises questions of legal competence about the functions and role of the Secretary-General, and concerns about uniformity of approach raised by the process. Paragraph (1) and the applicable Standards will better provide for a more uniform and systematic approach. Therefore, we propose deletion of paragraph (2).

We note that DR91 is restricted in its scope to 'information' We consider that longer-term custody of the biological, chemical and geological samples Contractors collect during the Contract term, as part of the common heritage of humankind, should also be covered in the regulations.
