- **53 (1)**: The introductory paragraphs of the draft regulations for all the 'Plans' that accompany the application for a Plan of Work need to be consistent with reference to any requirement to be submitted with the application for a PoW by regulation 7. We highlight that such introductory paragraphs across all these 'Plans' should also be consistent with each other as far as possible.

For 53(1), we suggest that as regulation 7 (3) (e) already sets out the requirement that the Emergency Response and Contingency Plan is submitted as part of the application for a PoW, text regarding the PoW can be deleted in this paragraph as it is duplicative.

Text should be retained in this paragraph that makes it clear that it shall be in accordance with Standards and take into account Guidelines. Wording should also be added that it shall be developed in accordance with this regulation 53, and in accordance with Annex V.

## **OFFICIAL**

We do not agree with the deletion of text that requires the Emergency Response and Contingency Plan to take into consideration the results of the EIA, and we propose removing the strike-through in the consolidated text and keeping that requirement to the end of the paragraph.
