A career diplomat, Bruno brings over 25 years of experience in international relations, diplomacy and global policy. His career spans three continents, where he held important roles in political, environmental and economic affairs.

Bruno joins the Authority from the United Nations Environment Programme, where he currently serves as the Deputy Director of the Ecosystems Division. Previously, he was UNEP's Regional Director for

Europe, based in Geneva, overseeing the pan-European region and the European Union. Prior to joining the United Nations, Bruno held senior positions with the European Union in Kenya and Cote d'Ivoire, as well as Belgium in South Africa, China and Japan.
