Report of the Credentials Committee

Credentials of representatives at the thirtieth session of the Assembly of the International Seabed Authority

Chair: Mr. Miguel Balaguer (Dominican Republic)

- 1. At its 216th meeting, on 21 July 2025, the Assembly of the International Seabed Authority appointed a Credentials Committee, consisting of the following eight members: Bahamas (The), Dominican Republic, Ireland, Kuwait, Nauru, Switzerland, United Republic of Tanzania and Zimbabwe.
- 2. On 23 July, the Credentials Committee held a meeting and elected Miguel Balaguer (Dominican Republic) as its Chair. The Committee examined the credentials of the representatives participating in the thirtieth session of the Assembly. The Committee had before it a memorandum by the secretariat dated 23 July 2025 on the status of those credentials.
- 3. As at 23 July, formal credentials issued by the Head of State or Government, by the Minister for Foreign Affairs or by a person authorized by the Minister had been submitted for the following 74 members of the Assembly participating in its thirtieth session: Angola, Antigua and Barbuda, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahamas (The), Bangladesh, Barbados, Belgium, Brazil, Cameroon, Canada, Chile, Cook Islands, Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Croatia, Cuba, Democratic Republic of Congo, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Fiji, France, Germany, Ghana, Greece, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Ireland, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Madagascar, Malta, Marshall Islands, Mexico, Micronesia (Federated States of), Monaco, Morocco, Mozambique, Nauru, Netherlands (Kingdom of the), New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Republic of Korea, Russian Federation, Samoa, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Switzerland, Togo, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Tuvalu, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Vanuatu, Viet Nam and Zimbabwe, as well as the European Union.
- 4. As at 23 July, information concerning the appointment of representatives participating in the thirtieth session of the Assembly had been communicated by means of email or in the form of initialled notes verbales from ministries, embassies, permanent missions to the United Nations, permanent missions to the Authority and other government offices or authorities for the following nine States: China,





Equatorial Guinea, Kuwait, Palau, Philippines, Suriname, Uganda, United Republic of Tanzania and Zambia.

5. The Chair proposed that the Committee accept the credentials of all representatives mentioned in the memorandum by the secretariat on the understanding that formal credentials of the representatives referred to in paragraph 4 above would be communicated to the secretariat as soon as possible. The following draft decision was proposed by the Chair for adoption by the Committee:

The Credentials Committee,

Having examined the credentials of the representatives at the thirtieth session of the Assembly of the International Seabed Authority referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 of the memorandum by the secretariat dated 23 July 2025,

Accepts the credentials of the representatives concerned.

- 6. The draft decision was adopted by the Committee without a vote.
- 7. Subsequently, the Chair proposed that the Committee recommend to the Assembly the adoption of the draft decision contained in paragraph 9 below.
- 8. In the light of the foregoing, the present report is submitted to the Assembly.

Recommendation of the Credentials Committee

9. The Credentials Committee recommends that the Assembly adopt the following draft decision:

Draft decision of the Assembly relating to the credentials of representatives at the thirtieth session of the International Seabed Authority
