1. A Contractor shall keep and maintain, fat a place agreed by the Contractor and the

returns or any other accounting or financial reports required by the Authority in
relation to Exploitation.

2. The Contractor shall prepare such records in conformity with internationally accepted accounting principles that verify, in connection with each Mining Area and the Contract Area, inter alia:

(a) Details and the total of the quantity in wet and dry metric tons and grade of the Minerals, by Metal, and grade and tonnage in dry metric tons of the Minerals by each Relevant Metals [and additional Minerals, if applicable] recovered from [each Mining Area and the Contract Area;

(b) Details of sales, shipments, transfers, exchanges and other disposals of <u>the</u> Minerals, <u>and grade and tonnage in dry metric tons of the Minerals by each Relevant</u> <u>Metals [and additional Minerals, if applicable] from by Metal, [each Mining Area and</u> <u>the Contract Area]</u>, including the time, destination, value and basis of valuation and the quantity and grade of each sale, shipment, transfer, exchange or other disposal;
