[2 bis. For the purposes of issuance of a certificate of sponsorship, the State of nationality means the State under whose law the corporation was incorporated. However, when the corporation is controlled by nationals of another State or States and has no substantial business activities in the State of incorporation, and the seat of management and the financial control of the corporation are both located in another State, that State shall be regarded as the State of nationality.]

2 bis should be deleted because it is more appropriately addressed in Annex I, section I paragraph 13 and the definition of "Change of Nationality."

In addition, while Canada has no concerns with the content of the first sentence of 2bis., which defines State of nationality as the State under whose law the corporation was incorporated, the second sentence incorrectly conflates elements of Effective Control with nationality.

What constitutes supporting evidence should be included in a Standard.

As currently drafted, sub-paragraphs 3(c)i and 3(c)ii do not distinguish between kinds of Sponsoring States (either a State Party of nationality or another State Party per Annex III article 4(3)). The DR also inaccurately implies that a State of nationality cannot have Effective Control.

Canada notes that the working group on Effective Control is deliberating the definition of Effective Control. Canada proposed a definition of Effective Control to this working group. The proposed alterations to DR 6(3)(c) are in line with the Canadian proposed definition.
