Canada proposes deleting DR 7 paragraph 2d as that content should be addressed in the Parent Company Liability Statement, which is still being negotiated.

Canada proposes deletion of text in DR 7 para 3(d) bis as it paraphrases what is in 48 ter, the substantive provision on Test Mining. In general, it would be better to

make reference to the relevant regulation as opposed to paraphrasing, as this could lead to inconsistencies and inaccuracies.
